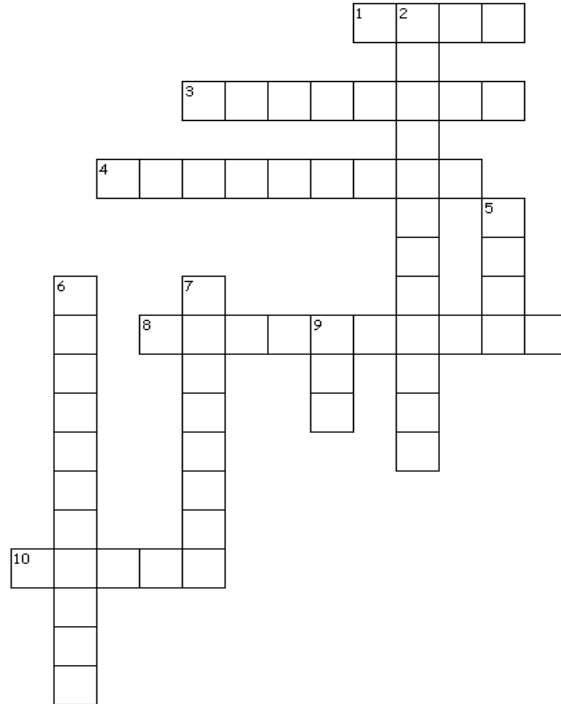


Outdoor Awareness
