First Visit

- Physical Exam
 - Discuss house/crate training, nutrition, and spay/neuter
- DAPP Vaccination
 - distemper, hepatitis, parainfluenza, & parvovirus
- Intestinal parasite screen
- Intestinal dewormer for hookworms, roundworms, tapeworms, & whipworms

*May be given at a later appointment if puppy is under 12 weeks

Second Visit (3 weeks later)

- Physical Exam
- DAPP Vaccination
- Rabies Vaccination
- Bordatella (kennel cough) Vaccination
- Intestinal Dewormer

Third Visit (3 weeks later)

- Physical Exam
- DAPP Vaccination
- Intestinal Dewormer

Fourth Visit (3 weeks later) *only necessary depending on age at start of vaccines*****

Physical Exam – The comprehensive examination allows the doctor to evaluate your puppy's attitude, heart, ears, eyes, lungs, abdomen, nose, throat, teeth, lymph nodes, bones, and skin. Please take this opportunity to discuss any concerns you may have regarding your pet's care.

Intestinal Parasite Screen – A fresh stool sample is evaluated to detect the presence and type of parasite infection by microscopic evaluation and the detection of parasite antigens using ELISA.

DAPP Vaccination – This is a core vaccination that protects your dog against the serious diseases that are present in our area:

Canine Distemper Virus – affects your dog's intestinal, respiratory, and neurological systems. Affected dogs can have permanent damage to their nervous systems. This virus is transmitted via discharge from the eyes and nose of affected dogs.

Canine Infectious Hepatitis – is a virus that causes severe liver disease, eye damage, and respiratory problems that can be fatal. This disease is spread via infected urine.

Canine Parvovirus – This is an extremely serious disease that affects the dogs digestive system. It can cause bloody diarrhea and vomiting; it destroys the immune system and can affect the heart in puppies. Death may occur in 48-72 hours if left untreated.

Canine Parainfluenza Virus – this virus causes kennel cough

Bordatella – This is a vaccination to protect against a highly contagious cough, which is caused by airborne bacteria. If untreated, kennel cough can progress to bronchitis and pneumonia.

Rabies – This is a core vaccination that protects against rabies. Rabies is a fatal disease that affects the nervous system and it is required by law to keep all pets up to date.
